Ecosystem Services The Hidden Wealth of the Planet

Ecosystems Services (ES) are the benefits provided by ecosystems to humans. The Life+ MGN develops biophysical evaluation models of ES of Natura 2000 network and defines their impact on human wellbeing.

Ecosystems Services are:

Provisioning Services

food, clean water, fiber, timber, medicinal resources:

Regulating Services

regulation of air quality, carbon storage, prevention of erosion, maintenance of soil fertility and pollination;

Supporting services

animal and plant biodiversity, natural habitats;

Cultural services

mental and physical health, tourism, aesthetic valorization, art, spiritual experience.









Payment for Ecosystem Services

Nature has a value

Payments for Ecosystems Services (PES) are economic incentives targeting individuals who, through voluntary certification, best practices, environmental communication promote the maintenance of Ecosystems Services and the deriving benefits.

The Life+ MGN identifies governance mechanisms aimed at conservation objectives of habitats and of species of Natura 2000 sites. Such mechanisms promote an optimal management of Ecosystem Services.

Pilot sites of Natura 2000

Nature makes a network

The project Life+ MGN includes 21 pilot sites belonging to the Natura 2000 network, a system of protected areas created under the EU Directive Habitat and Birds Directives. Pilot sites are distributed in seven Italian Regions, covering an area of 90,239 hectares.
